

As part of being open and honest with this apps capabilities, this section is here to inform you what personal information is accessed and how it is used.

One of the features this app can do is take your phone out of Silent/Vibrate/Priority/Do Not Disturb modes when you get a phone call more than once within short period of time by the same number so it will ring on the second call. This phone permission allows the app to access the phone number of the device this app is running on as well as the phone number that is incoming or outgoing. **For the purpose of this feature, the phone permission is only used for knowing when the phone rang.**

The next feature is one that can access the contacts on your phone. Because you may not want any caller to be able to take your phone off of silent, you can choose to only allow contacts that you have labeled as a favorite (also called starred contact) take your phone out of silent. The contacts permission technically gives the app access to your entire list of contacts and all their details. **This app only uses your contacts for knowing if the incoming caller is a favorite and nothing more.**

While these features can access your personal information, they only use them for the purposes stated and nothing else. More detailed descriptions of each Android app permission can be found under the Permissions section of this app. Lastly, even if I, the developer, wanted to be nefarious with your personal/private info, I could not as this app does not have the Internet permission that would be needed to download that information from your device.
